FULL & PART TIME LIFEGUARDS/INSTRUCTORS

The Lifeguard/Instructor position is a key component to the Leisure Services Department providing programs to the citizens of Weyburn at the Weyburn Leisure Centre. Currently, the Leisure Department is accepting resumes for Full & Part Time Day Shift Lifeguard/Instructor positions.

The Lifeguard/Instructor is required to work a variety of shifts, including weekends, to meet program requirements and the successful candidate will report directly to the Program Coordinator. The Lifeguard/Instructor will be required to:

- attend in-service training sessions as well as utilize set pool time for personal fitness and maintenance of certification levels;
- administer emergency procedures, enforce aquatic safety & facility operating policies;
- carry out the duties of water safety instruction, life safety and patron safety;
- assist with pool maintenance and other program services when necessary;
- maintain and upgrade certifications as required;
- learn Cashier Procedures and assist in this area when needed;
- assist with programming tasks;
- complete any other job duties the Program Coordinator may assign from time to time; and
- maintain appropriate personal attire and hygiene.

The successful candidate will be certified in Standard First Aid or equivalent, CPR "C", Bronze Cross, NLS, WSI and Life Saving Instructor; however, the Weyburn Leisure Centre is willing to train for all courses required. Salary is \$10.42(starting) per hour (Subject to C.U.P.E. Local 90 Agreement). Additional hourly wage incentives are provided for different qualifications each candidate possesses.
